She was a main partner when WHO Ageing and Life Course Department conducted the first and only multi-centric study on Elder Abuse "Missing Voices" more than 20 years ago (sponsored by the Dutch Government). The results of this study were instrumental for the consolidation of INPEA. WHO should mobilize efforts to repeat this pioneer study which, in 2002, tackled all the five priorities identified by WHO in 2002 - including a clear link between Ageism and Elder Abuse, clearly enunciated in the report still available on the WHO site. Lack of institutional memory (what had been done before by pioneers such as Podnieks) is a form of ageism
